Meet the Directors:

<u>Jon Brill</u>

Music Educator, Percussionist, and Composer. Mr. Jon Brill is a central figure in the Music department at Eagle Valley Middle School. A Reno Nevada native, he earned his Bachelor of Music in Music Education from the University of Nevada – Reno in 1999 and a Masters Degree in Music Performance—Composition in 2017. His musical ensembles at Eagle Valley Middle School have received excellent and superior ratings at local area music festivals. In 2007, Mr. Brill was the recipient of the Eagle Valley Middle School Educator of the year award and the Carson City Rotary teacher for the month of March.

Mr. Brill has composed a variety of works for Band, Orchestra, Choir, Percussion Ensembles, and for an assortment of smaller chamber groups. Several of his compositions are currently in publication. His composition "In the Dark Shadows of the Moon" was featured at the 2016 new music reading session at the prestigious Midwest Band and Orchestra Clinic in Chicago III. As a percussionist, Mr. Brill frequently performs with the Reno Wind Symphony. In addition to his teaching duties at Eagle Valley Middle School, Mr. Brill teaches private percussion lessons, and has worked with various percussion students and sections throughout Northern Nevada.

Mr. Brill is a member of ASCAP, the National Association for Music Education, Phi Mu Alpha, Phi Kappa Phi, and the Golden Key Honor society. He takes up residence in south Reno, and in his free time, enjoys the outdoors, loves to run, Rock out on his Drums, loves to spend time with his awesome dogs Thor and Roscoe, and is an avid San Francisco Giants Baseball fan.

<u>Dr. Brian Fox</u>

Brian Fox is Director of Orchestras for the Carson City School District, where he coordinates the Northern Zone Honor Orchestra, conducts Pit Orchestra for Carson High School musicals, and serves as Co-Chair for the NMEA All-State Orchestra. He is Concertmaster of the Carson City Symphony. Brian also performs with Northern Nevada String Serenade and the Reno Philharmonic and gives annual summer recitals with pianist Eric Kao. In 2011 he performed a series of recitals with Mexican pianist Enrique Salas Durazo, featuring the music of Astor Piazzolla. In 2012 he toured Uruguay as part of the Academic Chamber Orchestra of Montevideo. He received the Vertchamp Award for Musical Excellence from the University of California, Riverside in 2013. He holds a Ph.D. in Latin American Literature, also from UC Riverside. Brian loves spending time with family and friends, cooking, meditating, hiking, and reading
