- C.) **Play with good tone and proper posture.**
- D.) **Don't waste our time by being disruptive.**
- E.) **The most important thing is to have fun and enjoyable time.**

STEP ONE: VERBAL WARNING

STEP TWO: First Documented Offense

- A. Discussion of inappropriate behavior
- B. IC Documentation of inappropriate behavior
- C. Possible consequence (teacher discretion)
- D. Possible parent contact (teacher discretion)

STEP THREE: Second Documented Offense

- A. Discussion of inappropriate behavior
- B. IC Documentation of inappropriate behavior
- C. Parent contact (required of teacher)
- D. Consequence given by teacher

STEP FOUR: Third Documented Offense

- A. Discussion of inappropriate behavior
- B. IC Documentation of inappropriate behavior
- C. Parent contact (required of teacher)
- D. Referral to office

STEP FIVE: Fourth Documented Offense

- A. Teacher/Student conference
- B. IC Documentation of inappropriate behavior
- C. Parent contact (required of teacher)
- D. Referral to office
