## **Meet the Director**

Mr. Jon Brill is a cornerstone of the music department at Eagle Valley Middle School. A native of Reno, Nevada, he earned his Bachelor of Music in Music Education from the University of Nevada, Reno in 1999, followed by a Master's Degree in Music Performance with an emphasis in Composition in 2017. Under his direction, the musical ensembles at Eagle Valley have consistently earned excellent and superior ratings at regional music festivals. In recognition of his dedication to education, Mr. Brill was named Eagle Valley Middle School Educator of the Year in both 2007 and 2025 and was honored as the Carson City Rotary Club's Teacher of the Month in March 2007.

An accomplished composer, Mr. Brill, has written works for bands, orchestra, choir, percussion ensembles, and a variety of chamber groups. Several of his compositions are currently in publication. His piece *In the Dark Shadows of the Moon* was featured in the 2016 New Music Reading Session at the prestigious Midwest Band and Orchestra Clinic in Chicago, Illinois.

As a percussionist, Mr. Brill regularly performs with the Reno Wind Symphony and plays drums for the band "Drinking with Clowns." In addition to his full-time teaching at Eagle Valley, he offers private percussion instruction and has worked with percussion students and ensembles across Northern Nevada.

Mr. Brill is a member of ASCAP, the National Association for Music Education, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, Phi Kappa Phi, and the Golden Key International Honour Society. He lives in south Reno and, in his free time, enjoys the outdoors, running, rocking out on his drums, cheering on the San Francisco Giants, and spending time with his two beloved dogs, Thor and Roscoe.
